



Occupational Employment and Wages in North Carolina (OES) Iredell County

The employment and wage data represented here are estimates only. Due to confidentiality and quality criteria, the Labor Economic Analysis Division cannot produce them for every occupation in every geographic area. Data for the surveys were collected on different occupational structures and therefore are not directly comparable. The Bureau of Labor Statistics is now reporting the Occupational Employment Survey estimates annually. Each annual estimate is based on the most recent two semi-annual surveys, and represents the most current data available. These annual estimates are published in late spring.
